The islands are home to the Tiwi people, coastal island Aborigines with permanent smiles. Bathurst Island will reveal scenes to you seldom viewed by outsiders and leave you with a lifetime memory and a longing to return.

TIWI ISLANDS



- Make your way to the General Aviation Terminal, Darwin Airport by 7.30am (own expense)
- Depart 8.00am for the 30 minute flight to Bathurst Island to join a guided journey through the modern day Aboriginal community of Nguiu
- Visit the museum with its displays of traditional art and depictions of the Tiwi ‘Dreamtime’ stories and the Early Mission Precinct with its Tiwi style Catholic Church
- Visit the Art Centres to purchase Tiwi art at island prices
- A highlight of the day is spending time with the Tiwi ladies and our Guides enjoying billy tea and damper
- Witness traditional totem dances and a smoking ceremony and hear the meaning behind them
- Visit a local waterhole for a swim, if conditions permit
- Visit a Tiwi burial site and learn about the complex rituals associated with the Pukamani poles (Burial Poles)
