

Sample Itinerary, five day accommodated, Kakadu, Katherine.

Day One ;

On arrival at Darwin airport, ex flight, you will be met by your Aussie Adventure guide, transfer to the vehicle and depart Darwin, on the road to Kakadu National Park. On the way, you will take a break for a meal at the bark Hut Inn, a quaint roadside inn along the Arnhem Highway. Continue into the park, and head up to the impressive Ubirr rock art and shelters site, overlooking Arnhemland and the East Alligator river. After exploring this area, return to Jabiru and check in at the Gagudju Crocodile hotel for the night.

Day Two;

After breakfast in the hotel, take an 8.30 departure on a 50 minute fixed wing scenic flight over Kakadu – giving you a bird's eye view of the area and the imposing Arnhemland escarpment. Continue on to Bowali visitor centre – the headquarters of Kakadu, and home to an interesting display of Aboriginal art and interpretation of the environment. Continue to Nourlangie rock art galleries and explore the various art sites and view points. After exploring Nourlangie, move up to Cooida Lodge and enjoy lunch at the hotel restaurant. Visit nearby Warradjan Aboriginal interpretive centre before embarking a 2 hour evening sunset cruise on Yellow Waters. This boat cruise will give you the opportunity to enjoy the wetlands and river habitat which typify Kakadu, and you will enjoy views of some of the wildlife of the area - many different birds and with luck the iconic "Saltie" or Estuarine Crocodile. After the cruise make your way back to the Gagudju Crocodile hotel for your dinner and overnight accommodation.

Day Three;

After breakfast in the hotel, we take the road towards Katherine. With a stop at Edith Falls for lunch and a refreshing swim, we will continue to Katherine gorge and take an afternoon boat cruise, exploring the gorges for which this area is famous. The cruise will display some very different and impressive scenery in an area known to have been inhabited by Aboriginal people for up to 40 000 years. After the cruise, drive to the township of Katherine and check in at Knott's Crossing resort for your overnight accommodation.

Day Four;

Make an early start out of Katherine, heading North on the Stuart Highway, through Pine Creek, Adelaide River, and into Litchfield National Park. Make stops at Florence Falls and the amazing termite mounds of Litchfield. Continue on to Wangi Falls, where you may be able to enjoy another swim. Lunch at Monsoon café – don't forget to try the delicious Mango cheesecake! Continue back towards Darwin via the Cox Peninsula road, arriving back at the Darwin Central Hotel in the evening.

Day Five;
